Reach Child and Youth Development Society holds the three-year accreditation for Community Services: Child and Youth Services, and Community Services: Respite Services. CARF (The Commission of Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities).

Reach Delta Connex Parent Peer Group Program

The parent group is an oportunity for parents with children who have FASD or other complex behaviours to come together. At the group they can learn and reflect on their lives as parents of children that may behave in ways that are unexpected and a challenge to understand.

The parent group will focus on a variety of topics that are important to parents. At the end of each group session parents will set the topic for the following month. They can choose from given topics or identify a new topic. At all sessions parents will have an opportunity to interact and get to know one another. Resources that will assist parents and families will be developed and distributed. These may include such items as educational pamphlets, helpful

ooks, and rmation on sources.

Some of the topics to be covered are:

Learning: How your child learns differently and how to support progress.

Emotional Well-Being: Management of anger and other emotions that go along with parenting.



Health and Wellness: How to fit physical fitness and personal activities into your life.

Relationship Building: How getting closer with your child will improve behaviour and learning.

Dependence and Independence: How to encourage responsibility, but recognize the value of supports.

Celebrating the Children: How to adjust your perspective and avoid being overwhelmed by your child's struggles.

Family Life and Disability: The effects of having a child who needs extra support and how to keep it positive.

Benefits of a Parent Peer group

The Delta Connex program is about making connections and improving the quality of life for children and their parents. The objectives of the Delta Connex Parent Peer Group are:

- to facilitate parents' skill development and knowledge base about their child's condition
- to support parents' emotional well-being
- to assist parents' in strengthening their relationship with their children
- to provide a welcoming space where parents can share eperiences, knowledge and support
