# Reach ABA Program

The Reach ABA Program is for children with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) living in Delta, Surrey or Langley. It is a skill-building program that uses the principles of Applied Behaviour Analysis to teach young children with ASD functional communication, play, social interaction, academic, fine motor and self-help skills.


#### Reach ABA Program for Children Under 6

The Reach ABA Program is a highly structured intervention program that uses teaching methods such as Discrete Trial Training (DTT) and Natural Teaching Strategies (NTS). DTT incorporates errorless learning, prompting and reinforcement. NTS is based on the child's interest and incorporates

choices, reinforcing materials, and reinforcing consequences.

The Reach ABA Program offers two options: Centrebased ABA or Home based ABA. The ABA team includes an Associate Behaviour Consultant and a Behaviour Interventionist.

A Behavioural Consultant will coordinate the child's Behaviour Plan of Intervention (BPI), covering all child development domains.



Children's progress is monitored and updated at monthly team meetings. All program material are provided.

#### Option 1: Centre-Based ABA Program

- Children receive 40 hours of one-to-one intervention each month at a Reach ABA centre.
- An interdisciplinary team consisting of a Behaviour Consultant, a Speech-Language Pathologist, an Occupational Therapist, an Associate Behaviour Consultant and a Behaviour Interventionist.
- All program materials are provided.



- Children receive 30 hours of one-to-one intervention each month in their own home.
- A team consisting of a Behaviour Consultant, an Associate Behaviour Consultant, and a Behaviour Interventionist.
- All program materials are provided.

### Reach ABA Program for Children Over 6

Services include consultation and training from a Behaviour Consultant, Speech-Language Pathologist and Occupational Therapist.
