 At Reach we believe in the potential of every child and we know that each child is unique. We work together with families to recognize each child's strengths and develop their abilities.



Reach Child and Youth Development Society holds the three-year accreditation for Community Services: Child and Youth Services, and Community Services: Respite Services. CARF (The Commission of Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities).

Reach Counselling Services Program

The Reach Counselling Services Program provides counselling and consultation for families, individuals and couples in Delta who have a child with a developmental disability. We also provide play therapy and counseling for children and youth who have a developmental disability.

Counselling for adults may address a variety of concerns ranging from marital stress to depression to social anxiety. Services for young children up to age 12 may include play therapy and parent/child interaction guidance. Consultation on how to access other long-term resources is also provided.

Educational seminars are scheduled

regularly to parents and child care professionals on topics such as self-esteem, depression, attachment, and anxiety.

The program is open to any family in Delta who has a child with a developmental disability, or any family that is already accessing one of our other services.

Benefits of Counselling Services

At Reach we understand that having a child with a developmental disability, or having a disability yourself, can create extra stress. Talking with a counsellor can often be very helpful. A counsellor can create the opportunity for the client to review their options and gain new perspectives. Outcomes for children are more likely to be better when parents feel positive and are able to cope.

Referrals to Reach Counselling Services Program

Families who are receiving other Reach services can access counselling service through a staff contact person at Reach or by emailing or calling the contact number listed.



Families in Delta with a child who has a developmental disability who are not receiving other Reach services can be referred by a professional from another agency in the community, or can self refer by contacting the Program Coordinator at (604)946-6622, extension 342 or counselling@reachchild.org.

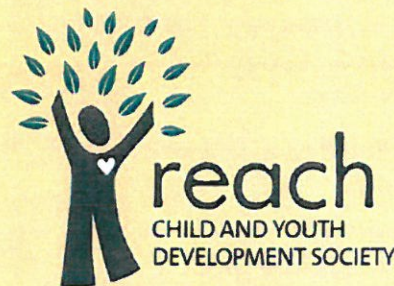
Individualized We recognize and respect the diversity and uniqueness of families and children and provide individualized approaches to goal identification and service planning.
